

You are invited to the Lakeville North Mock Trial Tournament  
Saturday January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2012

(The “Minneapolis Mock Trial tournament” is year two of a break. Lakeville North is located 5 miles south of Apple Valley High School. We will do our best to fill in for a second year)

Details: Each team will compete in two trials, one on each side.

All undefeated teams (2-0) will advance to a championship trial. If there is an odd number of 2-0 teams, the highest 1-1 team will also advance.

Each school is asked to provide one qualified mock trial judge for each 1-2 teams entered. If you enter 1 team, you would bring one judge. If you enter two teams you would bring 1 judge. If you bring 3 teams, you would bring 2 judges. If you bring 4 teams you would bring 2 judges.

A qualified judge is defined as any person with high school mock trial experience who feels comfortable ruling on and scoring a trial. A school’s attorney coach, volunteer attorney, or experienced teacher coach all meet this definition. Judges for schools advancing to the championship rounds would be expected to be available to judge the third trial.

The registration fee is \$40 for each team entered. Please pay ahead of time or have check in hand (still trying to track down an entry from last year and that doesn’t seem fair)
