

**Rook E. Greenwood vs.
Chief Billie Durden, in His/Her Individual Capacity as Chief of the Reillyville Police**

Case Clarifications #2

1. The materials state that April 2, 2011 is a Friday and April 4, 2011 is a Sunday. These dates are off by one day. April 1 is a Friday and April 3 is a Sunday. These dates are significant to the case, as the complaint letter from Rin T Tin was hand delivered on April 2, 2011 (which would be a Saturday) and the Loudermouth political rally was on April 4, 2011 (which would be a Monday, not a Sunday).

Change the dates to Friday, April 1, 2011 and Sunday, April 3, 2011.

2. Just wanted to bring up Exhibit 1; pg. 40: Looks as though the two postings (on the top of page 40) by Rook Greenwood were switched (the times are off on the chronology). Can we have this clarified?

4. After carefully studying the exhibits, we wonder if there was a typing mistake in the exhibit that is to be enlarged. It makes so much more sense to us that it would be exhibit 1 and not exhibit 5. Is there any chance exhibit 1 can be enlarged in addition or instead of exhibit 5?

There was no typing mistake. The exhibit that teams can choose to enlarge per Rule 4.11 is Exhibit 5B.
