1. Disregard any reference to height or weight of defendant or plaintiff.  
Delete from Statement of Linn Anderson: Page 25 line 57  
**“I am 5'11" and I understand that Shannon is around 5'7.”**
- 2. Shannon Spain cannot deny that she made the phone call to Linn Anderson transcribed in Exhibit 2.**
3. Exhibit 6: ***Has been modified***: Soccer Field – if you have enlarged this exhibit already please add these changes to your enlarged copy. – X marks where the accident happened on the field, the stands have been added, and the identification of the team goals.

4. Disregard any reference to height or weight of defendant or plaintiff  
Statement of Shannon Spain: Page 19
    - Delete from Shannon Spain statement line 35-36.  
**“I may only be 5’7” and 145 pounds soaking wet, but”**  
The sentence should read, “I can kick a penalty shot with the best of them, if I say so myself.”
- Statement of Coach Terry Dillion: Page 22
- Line 26 replace the word **“scrawnier”** with the word **“scrappier”** player.
- Statement of Linn Anderson: Page 24-25
- Line 23 delete the word: **“bigger,”**

- Line 57 delete the words: “is smaller than me and that he/she”  
The sentence should read, “I cannot help it if Shannon fell on my leg and hurt her/his back.”

Statement of Cameron Strong: Page 27

- Line 33-35 delete the sentence “Spain’s smaller stature just compounds the risk. Anytime you put a 5’7” small-framed player in a very physical game against players who are 5’11” you are asking for trouble.”
- Change the sentence to read: “Anytime you put together two competitive, rival teams such as Centreville and Pleasantville with such high expectations and aggressive players you are just asking for trouble. This is not a sport for the meek.
