

**MSBA Administrative Law Section – Section Council Meeting Minutes**

**Council Members Attending:** Chairman David Aafedt, Julie Brunner, Todd Guerrero, Eric Lipman, Jocelyn Olson, Tom Pursell, Louis Thayer and Patricia Winget.

**Council Members Absent:** David Schultz and Eric Swanson.

**Treasurer's Report:** Judge Lipman presented the year-end report which reflected a balance of \$7,632.58. These figures do reflect the receipt of \$2,360 in revenue from membership renewals for fiscal year 2008-2009.

**Old Business:**

1. The Council began with additional discussion, brainstorming and planning for upcoming CLE activities. The Council came to consensus upon plans for three Continuing Legal Education courses to be sponsored by the Section: A December course on the use of the Governor's power to veto state agency rules; a January course on the collateral consequences in administrative law that follow from a criminal conviction; and an April course on the use and disclosure of agency investigative files.

2. The Council expressed interest in a proposal to underwrite a stipend for a summer internship in the area of administrative law, but wished to obtain additional details about such a program before it entertained a motion to approve an expenditure of Section funds.

3. A discussion occurred on the proposal that the Section convene a working group on the possible transfer of implied consent jurisdiction from the state courts to OAH. Because of the complexity and sensitivity of transfer-related talks, the Council requested that Chairman Aafedt have additional consultations with MSBA President, Michael Ford on how the Section could be most useful.
