Treasurer's Report: Judge Lipman presented the November report reflected a balance of \$7,774.58. Included in these figures were deductions for meeting and administrative expenses.

Old Business:

1. The Council began with additional discussion, brainstorming and planning for upcoming CLE activities. The Council came to consensus upon plans to move the CLE on Gubernatorial Veto of State Administrative Rules to January. Further, the Council will explore hosting a U.S. Senate Recount (Election law) CLE during the spring and a course offering on disclosure of data in agency files for the year-end Annual Meeting. Additionally, Todd Guerro will undertake outreach to the officers of other MSBA Sections on possible co-sponsorships.

2. The Council discussed further a proposal to underwrite a stipend for a summer internship in the area of administrative law, but deferred a formal motion on such a plan to the December Council meeting. In the meantime, Chairman Aafedt will undertake outreach to the officers of other MSBA Sections on possible contribution matches.

3. Further discussion on the proposal that the Section convene a working group on the possible transfer of implied consent jurisdiction from the state courts to OAH, was deferred a formal motion on such a plan to the December Council meeting.
