MSBA BANKRUPTCY SECTION

Minutes of Section Meeting on November 15, 2011

A meeting of the MSBA Bankruptcy Section was held on November 15, 2011. Those in attendance are listed above. Chairperson Henry Wang called the meeting to order at approximately 6:00 p.m. A motion to approve the Minutes of the October 18, 2011 meeting was made and approved by a voice vote.

Old Business: Henry acknowledged the problems with sound in the past, and indicated the changes made: placing the buffet line at back by the noisy door and the seating in the front; providing one microphone for each speaker; and increasing amplification. Henry also acknowledged the past seating

problems and stated that for this meeting, there was seating provided for 90-100 people. [The email giving notice of the meeting and providing a registration link stated that members need to register by the stated deadline to enable the Section to reserve enough seating with Kierans.]

New Business: Henry stated that the formation of the education committee for this year was completed and that all members from last year were returning. Henry stated that the list of officers and education committee members was assembled and is available on the section website and will be routed by the MSBA. Lastly Henry announced that the ***Holiday Reception will be held on December 20 at The Lexington in St. Paul.***

Report from the Court: Chief Judge Kishel announced two items: (a) that his new calendar clerk, hired after the retirement of longtime clerk Anita Larson, has started working; and (b) that Judge Kressel has announced his retirement effective June 30, 2012, but Judge Kressel will be on recall status. The job opportunity has been posted on the websites of the Bankruptcy and 8th Circuit Courts.

Report from the U.S. Trustee: None.

Pro Bono Committee Report: David Galle reported that the pro bono efforts and services were presently strong, but stated that the Committee and the partner service organizations are always looking for volunteers. David passed around a sign up sheet for volunteers.

Bankruptcy Bulletin: Lara Glaseman reported that the transition of the Bankruptcy Bulletin was completed. She and John Lamey are co-editors in chief and there are 8 other editors. Lara stated that they hope to improve the regularity of the publication of the Bulletin.

Treasurer's Report: On behalf of Ryan Murphy, Henry reported that the Section is solvent.

Educational Program:

Education Committee Chair Amy Swedberg introduced Phillip Bohl, Clinton Cutler and Lara Glaesman who spoke on "Upcoming Amendments to Federal Bankruptcy Rules and the Bankruptcy Practice Committee's Recommendation for Changes to Local Rules." The speakers summarized the changes to Bankruptcy Rules 2019, 3001, 3002.1 and 4004 that go into effect December 1, 2011.
