

## **RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE OUT-STATE REPRESENTATIVE AT LARGE**

The out-state representatives are at-large members of the executive committee who reside outside of the seven-county metro area.

The out-state representatives should:

1. Regularly attend meetings of the Section and of the Executive Committee.
2. Participate (sometimes by telephone or e-mail) in the Executive Committee's decision-making process; contribute to discussions of section positions and policies.
3. Promote Section membership, and be available to greater Minnesota members who wish to voice concerns, either about the section or about larger family law issues.
4. Stay informed about new or pending legislation and recent cases affecting family law, and be aware of what, if any, position the section has taken on them.
5. Relay pertinent information about legislative changes to the local bar.
